Theme: Colour, light and weather

Here are some suggestions of things you could try at home linked to our current topic. If you do complete some of these then bring them in to share with us.

Communication and language: Can you think of some questions you would like to ask about the weather? With an adult can you use technology to try and find the answer through sources such as AI (Canva or ChatGPT, Alexa, Siri or on the internet)

PSHE: Can you think of things you like about your friends? What do you enjoy doing with your friends? What makes you a good friend?

Physical development:

Gross motor: Can you complete some exercises following the instructions on a video? Maybe use Joe Wicks, cosmic yoga or just dance/Go Noodle.

Fine motor: Can you cut up and make your own rainbow colour fruit kebabs?

Literacy: Can you collect and make groups of colours, find objects which start with the same letter as the colour they are e.g. blue balloon, yellow yoyo and red rose. Read and share stories which have colours in them such as Elmer, Red riding hood

Maths: go on a shape hunt, what shapes can you find in your home or outside? can you find a circle, square, rectangle triangle, can you take photos of them? Can you use your recycling to make a 3D shape model or item?

The world: What colours can you see in the natural world when you are out and about? Can you choose what clothes you need to wear to match the weather for the day (at the weekends)

Art and design: Can you make your own patterns using a range of colours, marks and tools
