

## Beechcroft Infants School Parental Involvement



### Parent support/involvement:

We hold Parents meetings 3 times a year when we will discuss how your child is in school and the progress they are making. For Parents with children on our SEN register during these meetings your child's Individual progress plan (IPP) or Positive handling plan (PHP) will be discussed with you. This is an opportunity for you to share and add your views which will form part of the targets set.

Early Help conversations are completed if there are continued concerns or a wider range of needs which could impact on your child's progress and development. We see it as a beneficial way to work together to support your child/family. As part of this process TAF (Team around the family) meetings are held on a regular basis and led by your identified lead professional (Children's Champion, Deputy Head or SENDCO). Education health care plan (EHCP) review meetings are held annually from the date of when the final plan was written (or every 6 months of child is under 5) and these meetings are led by the SENDCO and contributions requested from all agencies involved.
