- Talk to your grown ups about the places they have visited. Have they been to any other countries or continents? Have they got photos that you can see of the place that they have visited?
- Look for signs of Spring around you. Have you seen any blossom, buds, flowers blooming? Can you spot the **leaves, stem, petals and leaves**.
- Use the letter formation sheet sent home last term to practice forming your letters correctly - ask for another copy if you need it.
- Can you practice writing at home? If you write a story at home, please bring it in to share with your class.
- Practice weaving - tie sticks together and weave string or material around them. Add some natural objects (flowers, leaves) to make your own piece of art.
