Below are some activities to do during the week.

Have a look within your Year group and pick out as many as you feel you want to do.

Please include:

- Safer Internet Day – 8th Feb - assembly on this day. Theme this year is 'All fun and games? Exploring respect and relationships online'.
Assembly script powerpoint and all the resources needed are on Purple Mash (see the tab on the left – Safer Internet Day) I have also saved the assembly, script and resources list in the Online safety week 2022 folder in Computing on the staff drive.
Activity to go with the day:
I thought it would be really nice to complete the Kinder Internet Spell activity as it goes with the story that will be read during the assembly and it will make a great display for the ICT suite!
This year can I ask you to complete the activity on Purple Mash. I will set it as a 2Do for the whole school for that week.
It can be differentiated as there are icons and pictures that can be dragged and dropped onto the template to show how to be kind for FS and any lower ability and writing prompts for Years 1 and 2. Please can every child save their work, hand it in on the 2Dos and then I can go into each class and print off a selection.
If for any reason you are having problems with this online activity, then I can print off a paper copy to complete.
- There are lots of other lovely activities on the activity menu that you can complete during the week. Including Digi Duck Mashcams and creating new avatars.
- Please can you also watch the 'Jessie and Friends' Online safety education video specific for your year group during this week and complete at least 2 of the suggested activities that relate to the video.

Video 2 = Year 1

Video 3 = Year 2

I will send a letter/virtual letter home to parents before we watch the videos explaining the content and if parents have any issues to see myself or Jo.

- This week DOES NOT take the place of any online safety units of work for each year group. The online safety units must still be taught during the year and the education for a connected world framework must be followed on a weekly basis. (see revised computing provision overview that was updated September 2020)
Online safety is a massive part of our children's everyday lives now and is one of the most important aspects of our computing education.
- Take photos of anything you do and save in the folder on the staff drive please and we can share them on the website to raise awareness of the importance of online safety.
Please make sure the photos you take are of children who have permission to be on the website.
- Sorting activity

I will be setting up a sorting activity in the computer suite:

learners can decide what information is safe to be shared online and what should be kept private and offline.

You can encourage children to interact with this during the week when you are in the suite. It can also start discussions about what is and isn't safe to share online.

I will keep it up for longer than the week to give you all a chance to complete the activity.

Other activities you may wish to complete:

- See activity menu in folder
- On Purple Mash there is a Safer Internet Day section with lots of resources and activities.

Look at the supporting resources section at the bottom. You can set the 'Safer Internet Day quiz' as a 2Do for your class.

There is also some great Digi Duck Mashcams.

I will be sending home a letter to parents with a home activity to do as well to encourage families and communities to become involved.

- Please can I ask all staff members to complete the staff questionnaire. This is the same Please can you copy it for the TA's and support staff you have in your classes/year groups etc and can I have them back by Feb half term (18th Feb)
It can be completed online/on a computer and saved in the completed surveys folder.
It can also be accessed via Purple Mash too. Please let me know if you would like any help in doing it this way. I am happy to receive either paper or digital copies.
- Can I also please ask you to complete an Online Safety Pupil voice questionnaire during this week too. There is 1 for EYFS and 1 for KSI. These can be completed online and saved in the completed surveys folder. Please can you choose a MA, AA and LA child. Again, if a paper copy is preferred then I can accept those too.
