Dear Parents and Carers,

I am writing to share important information about certain products containing sand that may be contaminated with asbestos.

Although this relates to products used in homes and other settings rather than to our school building, we want to make sure families are aware and can check any relevant items they may have purchased.

Please read the guidance below and check any sand-based consumer products you may currently have at home, such as toys, hobby materials or decorative items.

**Important information about asbestos in some sand-containing consumer products**

The new guidance from GOV.UK explains what affected products are, where to find current product recalls, and what steps families should take if they think they have bought one of these items.

If a product you own appears on the recall list, please stop using it immediately and follow the disposal or return instructions provided. The guidance also explains how to clean up safely and who to contact if you are unsure.
